## Rambles

### Rambles

#### Wednesday 5 April - Teston Lock/Wateringbury

Meet in **Teston Lock** Car Park (ME18 5XB) at 11 am (fee payable) for a walk towards Wateringbury on one side of the Medway and back on the other. Lunch at **The Good Intent**, West Farleigh, at around 12.45 pm

#### Sunday 23 April - Percy's Ramble

Meet at 10.30 am near the **War Memorial at Meopham Green** for a circular walk. Lunch at **The Railway, Sole Street**.

#### Wednesday 3 May - Ranscombe Farm

Meet at 11 am in the car park of Ranscombe Farm Nature Reserve (opposite the Council tip on Cuxton Hill) for a circular 3 mile (ish) walk on paths and some open ground. On to the **White Hart** at Cuxton for lunch at around 12.45 pm

#### Sunday 28 May - Percy's Ramble

Meet at 10.30 am at **St Mary's Church, Lower Higham**, for a circular walk across the marsh. On to the **Cliffe Pools Café** for lunch.

#### Wednesday 14 June - Reculver to Herne Bay

Meet in the car park (fee payable) adjacent to Reculver Tower at 11 am to walk along the cliff top and promenade to Herne Bay. Lunch at **The Ship, Central Parade**, at around 12.45 pm. Those who do not wish to walk back to Reculver can wait at the pub to be picked up to return to their cars. If you walk both ways it

is about five miles and there are some steps from the cliff to the sea front but otherwise it is a flat walk and should be very pleasant if the sun shines for us.

Meet at 10.30 am in the car park at **Leybourne Lakes** (please check with Percy as to which car park he will be using) for a circular walk. On to **The White Hart, Cuxton** for lunch.
