In November National Highways announced their intention to amend plans near the river to support the Thames Freeport at Thurrock Council's request. They are now drawing up plans for a consultation on this and a small number of other local refinements, which follow on from the Community Impacts Consultation last summer.

National Highways are in the process of engaging with all host local authorities on the details of this consultation and further details will be shared after the engagement.
